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This is a public legal notice. It is not a consumer contract and it is not an offer capable of acceptance. The Website is an information and enquiry channel for businesses. Paid services are governed by the Master Services Agreement, the relevant service schedule or statement of work and, where we process personal data on a client's behalf, the Data Processing Agreement. Use of the Website is governed by our Website Terms of Use.



1. Status of this Notice

This notice identifies who operates the public websites at vistaweb.ltd and vistawebdesigns.co.uk (together, the "Website"). It is published so that a visitor can find, in one place, the information that United Kingdom company and electronic-commerce disclosure rules require on a commercial website, and the same class of particulars that a German Impressum would typically contain.

Vista Web Ltd is a private company limited by shares incorporated in England and Wales. It is not a German undertaking, it has no establishment in Germany, and publication of this notice does not amount to a submission to German law, to the Digitale-Dienste-Gesetz, to the courts of the Federal Republic of Germany, or to any other foreign forum. German imprint practice is used only as a convenient checklist of fields. The law that governs this notice, the Website Terms of Use and our contracts is the law of England and Wales. The courts of England and Wales have exclusive jurisdiction. See section 12.

The Website and our services are offered to businesses. They are not intended for personal or household use. By using the Website you represent that you do so in the course of a business, trade or profession.

Nothing in this notice transfers any right, creates a partnership or agency, or excludes or restricts a liability that the laws of England and Wales do not allow us to exclude or restrict. Clauses that allocate risk are intended to satisfy the reasonableness test in the Unfair Contract Terms Act 1977 where that Act applies.

2. Operator of the Website

The Website is operated by Vista Web Ltd, which also trades as "Vista Web". There is no separate trading vehicle and no German GmbH or other local subsidiary.

The registered office is the address at which documents may be served on the company. It is not a post-office box. Particulars on the public Companies House file prevail if they later differ from this notice. A draft note supplied internally for this pack is not treated as conclusive; the figures above follow the public register and the published Privacy Policy and Website Terms of Use.

3. Registered Particulars

Those instruments are the operative disclosure rules for this company. A German visitor may recognise the same fields under § 5 Digitale-Dienste-Gesetz. That recognition is a matter of layout. It does not import German public law onto a United Kingdom company that is not established in Germany.

If the company becomes VAT-registered, the number will appear on invoices and this notice will be updated.

The Website uses a cookieless, self-hosted analytics tool (Umami) as described in the Privacy Policy. This notice does not replace that policy.

8. Regulation, Insurance and Professional Rules

Website design, hosting, domain management, email management and search-engine optimisation are not, in the United Kingdom, reserved professional activities. We are not a member of a statutory professional chamber. There is no competent supervisory authority of the kind that § 5 Digitale-Dienste-Gesetz contemplates for authorisation-based trades, and none is required for the services described in our schedules.

Domain registration is subject to the rules of the relevant registry and registrar (including Nominet for many .uk names). Those rules bind the registrant contract. They do not replace the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales over disputes between Vista Web Ltd and a client, except to the extent a registry policy is mandatory as between registrant and registry.

No compulsory professional-indemnity scheme applies to this company by reason of a reserved title. Contractual liability is allocated in the Master Services Agreement. The liability cap in that agreement is the greater of twelve months' fees under the relevant schedule or £5,000, subject to the statutory carve-outs set out there. That cap is intended to be reasonable for a small professional-services company dealing with business customers who can insure their own risk.

We do not provide legal, tax, investment or regulated-credit advice. Nothing on the Website is a financial promotion.



9. Content Responsibility

Editorial and business responsibility for the content of the Website rests with Vista Web Ltd, acting through its directors named in section 4. 10. Dispute Resolution

Paid work is a business-to-business contract. The Master Services Agreement and each service schedule provide for good-faith discussion and, if that fails, mediation through the Centre for Effective Dispute Resolution (CEDR) before a party issues proceedings, except where an application for interim relief is reasonably required. Mediation is without prejudice to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.

We do not participate in consumer alternative-dispute-resolution schemes. The EU Online Dispute Resolution platform and the German Verbraucherstreitbeilegungsgesetz are aimed at consumer contracts. They do not apply to the contracts we offer. We are not obliged to use a consumer conciliation body and we decline to do so.

Nothing in this section stops a data subject using the complaint routes described in the Privacy Policy, including the Information Commissioner's Office and, where EU data-protection law actually applies to a particular interaction, the corresponding supervisory authority. Those routes sit outside the contract.



11. Relationship with Other Documents

This notice sits with the public documents on the Website. If there is a conflict about the same subject-matter, the following order applies, unless a later document says otherwise in express words:

1. Data Processing Agreement — on data-protection obligations only, and only where it has been executed;
2. Master Services Agreement;
3. the relevant service schedule or statement of work;
4. Website Terms of Use — for use of the public Website;
5. Privacy Policy, Accessibility Statement and Copyright Statement — as public notices;
6. this Impressum.

An unsigned page on the Website does not vary an executed contract. Pre-contract discussions remain subject to any mutual non-disclosure agreement that is in force.

12. Governing Law and Jurisdiction

This notice, and any non-contractual obligation arising out of or in connection with it or with use of the Website, is governed by the law of England and Wales.

The courts of England and Wales have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with this notice, the Website, or their subject-matter, including non-contractual disputes and claims. You and we submit to that jurisdiction.

That choice is intended to be reasonable. The company is incorporated and managed in England. The registered office, the directors' place of work for the company, the hosting described in the current hosting schedule and the governing law of the Master Services Agreement are all in England and Wales. A single forum avoids a multiplicity of proceedings. Business counterparties can take English legal advice and can sue and be sued here.

Mandatory rights that a foreign public law confers on a consumer, or on a data subject, remain available only to the extent that law itself applies and cannot be derogated from by agreement. Our services are not offered to consumers. We do not accept that the courts of any other country have jurisdiction over a claim by a business visitor or a business client.
